



Law Student Summer Position Description

Children's Law Center, Inc. (CLC) is accepting applications for our Summer 2024 law clerk position. This full-time position is unpaid, but we will work with you to find and secure other funding options. Our Summer Program is ten weeks, starting at the end of May.

Applications are considered on a rolling basis until positions are filled. Interested students should apply as early as possible and no later than December 31, 2023.

CLC is a non-profit legal service center protecting the rights of children and youth to help them overcome barriers and transition into adulthood, better advocate for their needs, and successfully contribute to society. It provides individual legal advocacy to children and youth, and through public policy work, training and education, impact litigation, and juvenile defender support services, seeks to improve the systems that serve them. CLC offers services in both Kentucky and Ohio and collaborates with other organizations within the region and nationally on a variety of topics.

Law students will have the opportunity to work on individual cases and advocacy in the following substantive areas: education, juvenile justice, custody, child victim legal assistance, civil rights actions, and youth re-entry civil legal services.

Students will assist attorneys with various tasks, including but not limited to legal research, drafting motions and memoranda, client intake, and interviews. Students will have opportunities to observe court hearings.
